Grama Swachhata Abhiyan:

The Grama Swachhata Abhiyan was organized for cleaning up of the village and awareness campaign to make people aware of health and sanitation the programme was successfully carried out with the active support by villagers

Kitchen Garden Project:

In order to make people aware of water conservation programs, a kitchen garden project has been undertaken by the volunteers to prepare the model of kitchen garden in order to use waste water for growth of crops for domestic purpose this program was very successful all the villagers were convinced to adopt this method of water conservation. Over four kitchen gardens were prepared by the students.

Water Management Project:

Water being one of the most precious fundamental natural resources, the protection and saving of water is the need of an hour. The problem of water shortage in the village was identified as one of the striking issues. Keeping in mind this fact, the water conservation project was undertaken in order to meet the water demand under which 10 contour bunds were constructed. Moreover, two Vanarai Bandhara were reconstructed along the river Kalu.

Besides this, other works at campus such as construction of road, preparation of school play ground and repairing of Stone fence of school were done with necessary help of school teachers.
